Suites and Apartment Rentals

For a greater measure of independence, opt out of the traditional hotel scene and rent a suite or apartment through one of Puerto Vallarta's many vacation rental agencies. Villa Shores bills itself as a condo-hotel. The unique arrangement combines the benefits of hotels and independent living; a knowledgeable staff is available to advise you and address concerns, and you can enjoy the privacy of a relatively small establishment. There are 10 suites in the complex with one to three bedrooms, and all have separate sleeping and living areas and waterfront views.

All-Inclusive Resorts

For many travelers, a relaxed vacation means forgetting about price tags and wallets and opting instead for a luxurious all-inclusive resort. Of Puerto Vallarta's many offerings, the Velas Vallarta is one all-inclusive resort with a wide range of suites. Remodeled in contemporary Mexican decor in 2005, the hotel's rooms include studios and one-, two-and three-bedroom suites. You may select a suite with a balcony overlooking an ocean view. All rooms have either kitchenettes or fully equipped kitchens.

Long-Term Stays

Staying in a suite can dramatically improve the quality of an extended stay. If business or pleasure brings you to Puerto Vallarta over many weeks or months, you can select a suite from various accommodations that cater to the long-term traveler.
